It is also quiet at FAWCO at the moment due to the summer holidays.

But FAWCO's "clubs in motion" is always happy to receive news from the clubs and this is what we sent in... something to be proud of!

NCT Lauf against cancer was a charity virtual event from 1st - 3rd July 2022. We had a Heidelberg International Women's Club team. With the km's that we counted in our team of 14 we raised money in support of the work at the NCT Heidelberg together with thousands of people worldwide. Under the motto "Alone. Together!",

everyone was free to choose their individual route and distance. Whether it was an ambitious run or a leisurely stroll: every step counted and every donation helped. Our team walked and ran a total of 404,61km's in 3 days! We came 32nd out of 240 teams!

Tiffany in our team came 4th out of 1408 women with 85,98km! Our certificate is attached below.

We have also participated in the City StadtRadeln challenge where we recorded all the km's we cycled as a team. It was a competition that involved completing as many daily journeys as possible in an environmentally friendly way using our bikes over a 21 day period. Every km counted. As a team we cycled 320km for Heidelberg.
